Piano Teaching in a changing environment

When making your own decisions regarding **face-to-face teaching**, we encourage teachers to be flexible and to make sure your decisions are based on the best and most reliable sources of information. You will find some quick links to guidance and support from the government, and EPTA's risk assessment document on the EPTA website. In addition, it may be helpful to review the Local Restrictions and Travel Guidance.

Private teaching in England is now allowed in your own home or another home and your **Public Liability Insurance** is valid for this work. You should complete a risk assessment and ensure that you **follow government guidance** in relation to **social distancing, ventilation, cleaning** and **interaction**.
